**COVID-19 Update #5 Term 3 (2021) From the Principal for Parents and Caregivers**

Dear Parents & Caregivers,

As COVID-19 restrictions are eased once again, Victoria Point State High School wishes to advise the following guidelines aligning with Queensland Health advice will remain in place to support students. Please encourage your child to maintain good hand hygiene and to stay at home when feeling unwell.

The requirement for all high school students and all staff in all schools to wear masks whilst at school remains in place for another two weeks unless health advice determines otherwise. This includes travelling to and from school and moving between classes, whilst in the classroom and at breaks. In environments whereby, active participation is required by students, under the direction of their teacher, face masks maybe removed and a 1.5 metre rule requirement implemented. A Parent/Caregiver will be contacted for any student refusing to follow the Queensland Health directive.
